CALL MEETING TO ORDER/ATTENDANCE:

- The Boulder Cemetery Advisory Committee meeting was called to order at 5pm.
- Attending: Rhonda Craft, Ellen Rae Thiel, Sally Buckles and Patricia Lewis;
 Absent: Matt Strowzewski
- Guest: Cmdr. Larrey Lattin on behalf of the VFW / American Legion

BUSINESS:

- Approve meeting minutes from April 12, 2023 were reviewed and approved as presented. (Ellen Rae Thiel/Patricia Lewis)
- Status of Columbarium project. Pat reported that the columbarium is ready to be installed; waiting for the concrete to be constructed. The Boulder Cemetery Care Corp (BCCC) invited members of the advisory committee to meet at the Boulder Cemetery to review a proposed alternate location for the concrete pad. Larrey Lattin joined the meeting at this time. The suggested location is parallel to the north fence line, approximately perpendicular to 2nd road. Installation goal is before the end of June. City of Boulder budgeted \$12k for the concrete pad. Dennis will choose from 3 concrete providers. Additionally the City has asked that the BCCC to provide a Letter of Intent to Donate the columbarium to the City (which is on the Council agenda for the June meeting). WHEREAS, on August 17, 2021, the Boulder City Council held a special council meeting to discuss a preliminary plan for ARPA fund utilization; and,

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2021, the Boulder City Council held a public hearing on the ARPA fund utilization overview to allow for public comment and questions; and,

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2021, at the regularly scheduled Boulder City Council meeting, the council unanimously agreed to adopt the utilization of ARPA funds as presented in the August 18, 2021, special council meeting and public hearing; and,

WHEREAS, \$50,000 of the ARPA funds were allocated to expand broadband with the City of Boulder, and \$20,000 was allocated to assist Jefferson County in the hiring of a grant writer/administrator; and,

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2021, the first of two disbursements in the amount of \$10,000 was disbursed to the Jefferson Local Development Corporation for the hiring of a grant writer/administrator; and,

WHEREAS, to date, the City of Boulder has not released the second \$10,000 disbursement to Jefferson Local Development Corporation, nor have they released any of the \$50,000 allocated to broadband expansion.

THEREFORE, NOW BE IT RESOLVED THAT: the Boulder City Council adopts this resolution reallocating the \$50,000 originally designated for broadband expansion, and the remaining \$10,000 originally designated for a second disbursement to Jefferson Local Development Corporation for the hiring of a grant writer/administrator, to the hiring of an interim ambulance manager, all related costs associated with retaining the interim ambulance manager, and all expenses associated with the interim manager's efforts to recruit and retain Boulder Volunteer Ambulance volunteers and strengthening emergency medical services provided by the Boulder Volunteer Ambulance.

RE: DONATION TO QUALIFIED ORGANIZATION

This LETTER AGREEMENT REGARDING DONATION OF COLUMBARIUM (hereinafter "the Agreement" or "this Agreement") is made and entered into by and between the City of Boulder, a political subdivision of the State of Montana (hereinafter referred to as "the City") and Boulder Cemetery Care Corp., a Section 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation (hereinafter referred to as "BCCC").

WHEREAS, the City has a cemetery;

WHEREAS, citizens of the City and of the general area surrounding Boulder, Montana are interested in having a columbarium at the Boulder Cemetery;

WHEREAS, BCCC wants to purchase a columbarium for the Boulder Cemetery; WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7-1-4124, MCA, the City is empowered to care for the Boulder Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws and applicable law, BCCC is empowered to purchase a columbarium for the Boulder Cemetery and to assist with the maintenance of the columbarium.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, terms and conditions set forth in this, the Agreement, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- PURCHASE OF THE COLUMBARIUM: BCCC hereby agrees to purchase a columbarium to be installed at the Boulder Cemetery in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein.
- 2. INSTALLATION OF THE COLUMBARIUM: The City agrees to construct or have constructed a concrete pad on which the columbarium will rest at a mutually agreeable location within the Boulder Cemetery. BCCC will pay for the installation of the columbarium on the concrete pad constructed by or for the City. Upon completion of the construction of the concrete pad, the City will have no further responsibility for the installation of the columbarium.
- DONATION OF THE COLUMBARIUM: BCCC agrees to donate the columbarium to the City and the City accepts the donation of the columbarium.
- 4. CONSIDERATION: In consideration for this Agreement, BCCC agrees to purchase the columbarium as set out in this Agreement and the City agrees to install the concrete pad on which the columbarium is to be installed.
- 5. RESPONSIBILITY: The City will take full responsibility for the columbarium, including but not limited to the sale of niches, opening and closing niches and collecting fees and payment for niches and their use. BCCC will have no further responsibility of any kind relating to the columbarium after the Effective Date of this Letter Agreement as set out above.

- DONOR RECOGNITION: Any recognition for the donation of the columbarium shall be made under the name of Boulder Cemetery Care Corp.
- 7. GOVERNING LAW AND VENUE: This Letter Agreement shall be governed by Montana law. Any claim or lawsuit regarding this Letter Agreement or the subject matter of this Letter Agreement must be filed in the District Court of Jefferson County, Montana.
